Descriptive Writing • Leverages descriptive detail to bring the audience into the episode. • Where appropriate, includes effective figurative language, dialogue, flashbacks/flashforwards, etc. to describe the topic.		
Purpose • Uses varied (or purposefully repetitive) language to emphasize major themes. • Reveals the major theme/purpose through descriptive language in the episode rather than explanation alone.		
Audience Consideration • Uses grammar and spelling <i>appropriate to audience/purpose</i>. • Where appropriate, provides background information to improve audience understanding.		
Organization & Editing • Breaks up major ideas into self-contained and coherent paragraphs. • Uses concise word choice, sentences, and paragraphs to relate the theme. • Ideas and major themes flow from one paragraph to the next throughout the essay.
